

Scholarships

Prior to applying for any possible scholarships, all school fees MUST be paid in full. All families are encouraged, but not required to apply for one or more of the scholarships offered by Concordia Lutheran School. These scholarships will be applied in the order identified within this policy provided the eligibility components have been met. Students MAY qualify for more than one scholarship. Families MUST apply for scholarships in order to receive an award. In some cases a family may be eligible for multiple awards or no award. Applications will be included in registration materials and will be made available upon request and on the school website. Scholarships are only available for students in K-8th grade.

Partner Scholarship - THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO MEMBERS ONLY. Eligibility is determined by active membership at Concordia Lutheran Church. This is determined when the active membership policy, approved by the Board of Education, is applied. All active members will receive a Partner Scholarship not to exceed \$2000 per student for 1st-8th grade, or \$250 per student for kindergarten, regardless of your family's financial situation. To be considered active, you will need to attend 26 services (July-June). This does not apply for those attending or going to attend CLHS.

Choice Scholarship (provided via the State of Indiana) - THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO NON MEMBERS AND MEMBERS. Eligibility is determined by guidelines as determined by the State of Indiana. Qualifying income levels will be made available once they have been provided to Concordia. A current 1040 tax form and documentation of any additional income you may receive is required.

Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) - THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO NON MEMBERS AND MEMBERS. Eligibility is determined by income level equal to 200% of the Free and Reduced lunch income levels provided by the State of Indiana. These amounts will be available once they have been provided to Concordia. A current 1040 tax form, or other income verification is required along with the SGO application.

Community Scholarship - THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS OPEN TO NON MEMBERS AND MEMBERS. This scholarship is a needs based scholarship based upon income. This option is utilized when other scholarship opportunities do not apply or are insufficient. Amounts will be determined through an application (which includes the application form, a current 1040 tax form, a written statement as to why the scholarship is needed, and a statement of amount you can contribute), a meeting with the principal, and Board of Education approval based upon available tuition assistance funds. This scholarship is disbursed on a first come first served basis.

Thank you for your interest in Concordia Lutheran School. The following information is provided about our tuition and fees.

***Enrollment Fee must be paid at time of enrollment to hold a place in the class. Enrollment Fee is non-refundable.**

Payment Options

Your choice of payment is determined when you sign a tuition contract. Existing tuition contracts are not automatically renewed. A new tuition contract must be signed at the beginning of each school year. Certain fees are due at enrollment, and are not eligible for a payment plan. In the event that any payment is returned for NSF, CLS will charge you a \$25 fee.

Method of Payment:

Payments may be paid with cash, check or money order, or via FDPay.

Pay In Full Option: (1 payment)

Pay balance in full on or before August 12, 2021. A \$25 late fee will be applied to any payment made after this due date.

Semester Payment Option: (2 payments)

This option allows you to split your tuition into 2 payments. 1st half payment is due on or before August 12, 2021, and 2nd half payment due on or before January 6, 2022. A \$25 late fee will be applied to any payments made after these due dates.

Monthly Payment Option:

Funds are automatically withdrawn from your bank account via FDPay. We have two 10 month plans in place (August-May) or (Sept-June).

School Fees

These fees are not included in tuition cost and do not qualify under any scholarships. Fees MUST be paid before any scholarship applications will be processed.

- Enrollment Fee– K-8= \$160 : Preschool= \$140
- PTL fee (annual)- \$10/family plus \$5/enrolled student.
- Milk Fee (Annual-Preschool only) \$51
- Band/Strings-(See Band/Strings Form on website under Programs tab) for program cost
- Athletic Fees-Differs with each sport.
- Lunch-\$2.75 per lunch (free and reduced lunches are offered to qualifying families)
- Extended Care– \$1.75 per child per 1/2 hour with a \$25 registration fee

Tuition Policy

At Concordia Lutheran School we seek to continually evaluate our programs in order to provide the best in Christian education utilizing all available resources. This includes, but is not limited to, our fiscal responsibility. We seek to maximize existing potential sources of income which can be utilized to benefit our school and improve upon the already high quality product. In light of this process, the School Board of Concordia Lutheran School has approved the following tuition policy to become effective for the 2021-22 school year.

To attend CLS, a student's parent(s) or guardian(s) must sign a tuition contract that specifies the payment option and personal responsibilities.

1. All tuition and outstanding obligations from any preceding year must be paid in full before a student will be allowed to register for the next school year. All fees must be paid prior to any scholarship applications.
2. Students withdrawing from school during a given month will be charged the full month's tuition.
3. When a student withdraws, tuition charges and all financial aid awards are pro-rated through the end of the month. Other fees are not prorated. The adjusted balance of tuition and fees will be used to determine the final amount or credit due.
4. Financial resources are applied to tuition in the following order.
*Partner Scholarship
*Choice Scholarship
*SGO Scholarship
*Community Scholarship
5. Scholarships awarded to students by CLS vary according to the family's financial need. CLS reserves the right to revise scholarships should the family's financial circumstances change and/or other resources become available to the family.
